## ***HOUSE REEF & SHORE DIVE***

Dive Pro Academy is situated on The Oberoi house reef that stretches from the north to the south along of Sahl Hasheesh beach. Packed with diverse marine life and an abundance of corals it is truly a delight for snorkelers and divers of all experience levels. A 75-metre jetty extends nearly from the dive club to the reef, with electric cars that are available for carrying equipment and divers for effortless access to the reef. In the north site there is big part of shallow water and connect with blue lagoon.

This "House Reef" boasts a spectacular array of marine life from the smallest to the largest creatures. With sightings of large pelages like barracuda, turtles and sea horse living around large piece of sea lettuce and glassfish and eagle rays are commonplace. ## *BUBBLEMAKER*

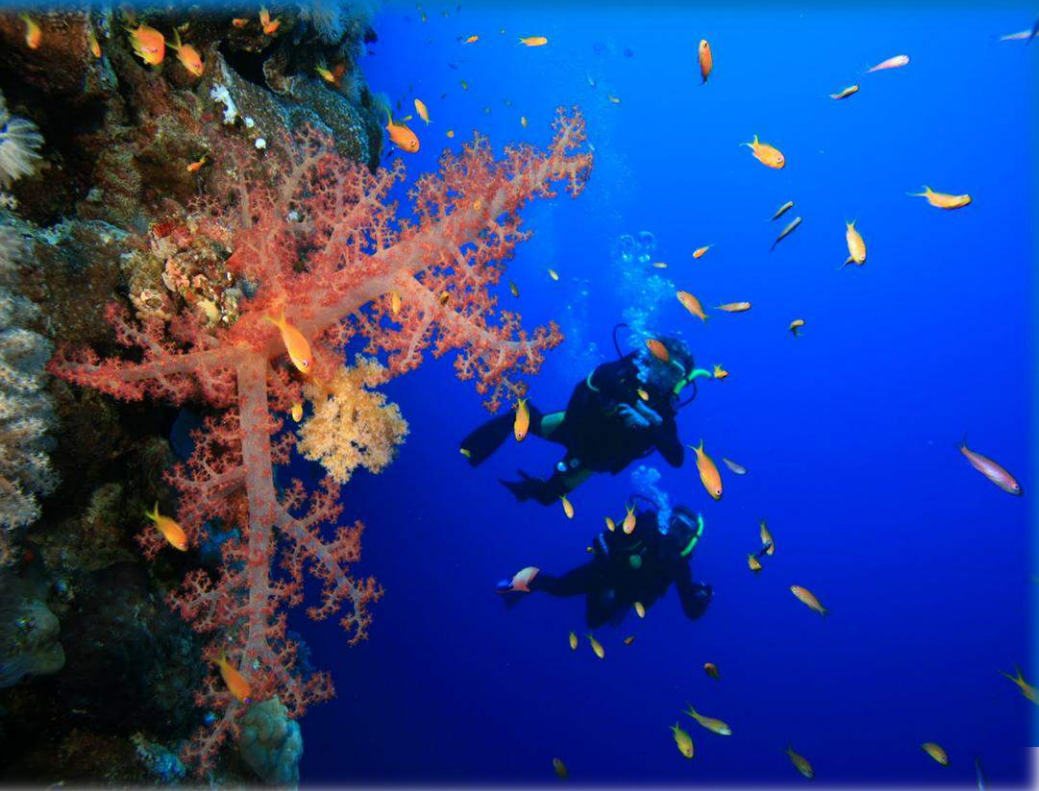

Children should be comfortable in the water, but they do not have to be super swimmers. They take their first breath underwater, learn about, and use scuba diving equipment made for children.

The course includes:

- One or two pool sessions in confined water
- A pool dive for 30minutes

Age Limit: 8 years to 10 years





## ***PADI OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE***

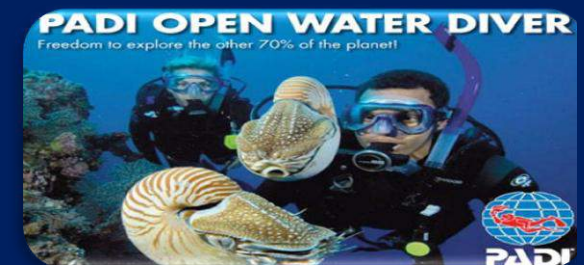
The PADI Open Water Diver course is the world's most popular scuba course, and has introduced millions of people to the adventurous diving lifestyle. The fun part about this course is well, just about all of it because learning to dive is incredible. You breathe underwater for the first time (something you will never forget) and learn what you need to know to become a certified diver. During the course, you will make at least five pool dives and four dives at local dive sites under the supervision of your PADI Instructor.

The course includes:

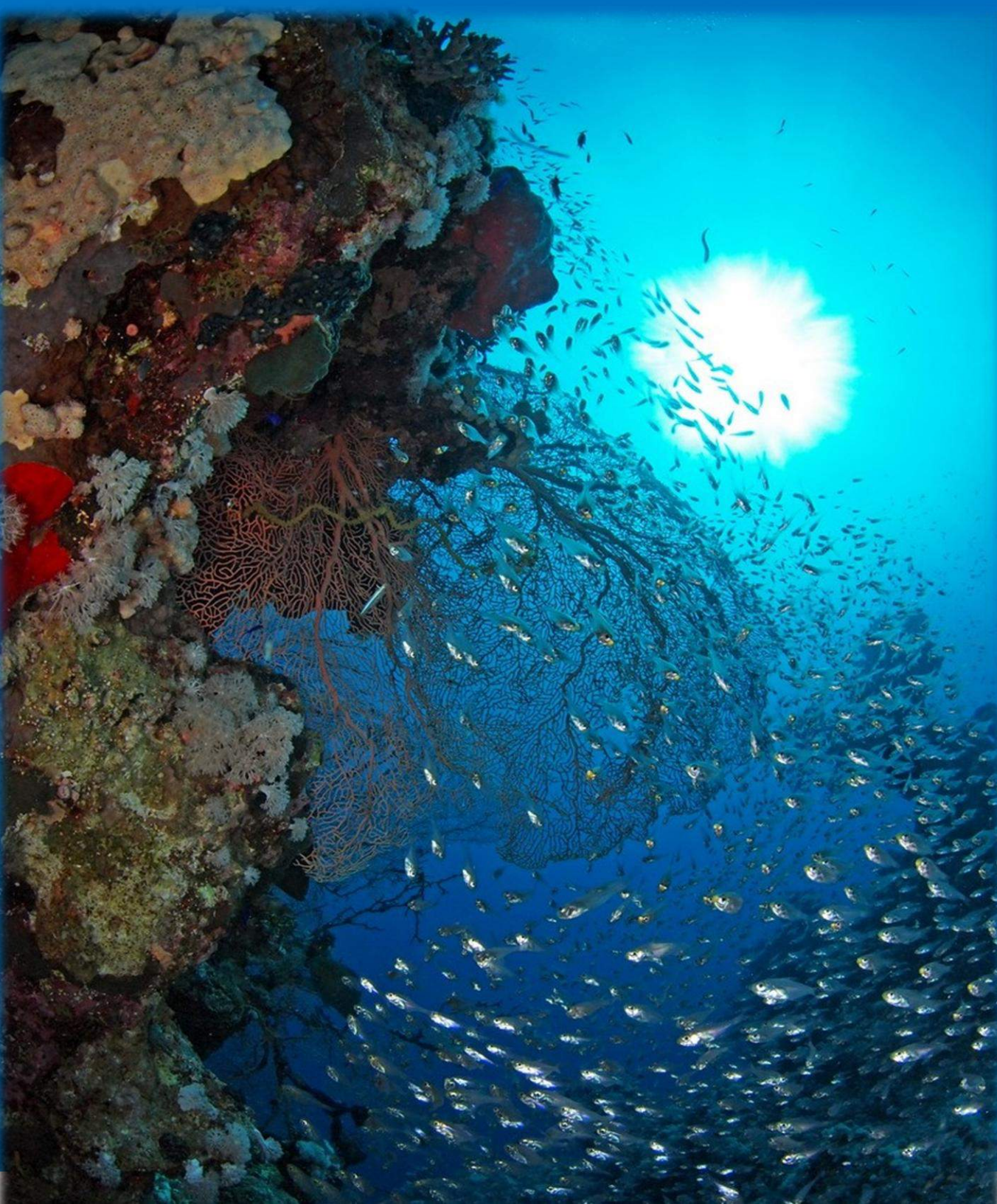
- Five theory sessions and five DVD sessions
- Five pool sessions
- Four qualifying sea dives to a maximum depth of 18 meters
- Dive manuals, tables, log books and coaching
- On completion, a certificate is issued by PADI
- A temporary license is issued which can be used till PADI Europe sends you the permanent PADI license to your address
- A Nitrox certification can also be done

Duration: Four days

Age Limit: 10 years and above







## *PADI SCUBA DIVER COURSE*

Short on time and long on the urge to become a certified diver? The PADI Scuba Diver certification might just be for you. This course requires less time than the PADI Open Water Diver course, covering only the first three of five sections of knowledge development, the first three of five pool sessions, and the first two of four open water training dives, resulting in a limited certification. Particularly if you expect to go scuba diving primarily in the company of a dive guide or if you have limited time to devote to scuba certification, consider becoming a PADI Scuba Diver. This certification allows for ample dive experience and is a good warm-up for the Open Water Diver course, if that's your ultimate goal.

The course includes:

- Three theory sessions and three DVD sessions
- Three pool sessions and two open water sea dives to a maximum depth of 12 meters
- Dive manuals, tables, log books and coaching
- A temporary license is issued which can be used till PADI Europe sends you the permanent PADI license to your address

Duration: Two days

Age Limit: 10 years and above







## *PADI ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE*

Exploration, Excitement, Experiences! They are what the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course is all about. In addition, no, you do not have to be “advanced” to take it – it is designed so you can go straight into it after the PADI Open Water Diver course. The Advanced Open Water Diver course helps you build your scuba skills so you can become more comfortable in the water. This is a great way to get more dives under your belt while continuing to learn under the supervision of your PADI instructor. This course builds on what you have learned and develops new capabilities by introducing you to new activities and ways to have fun scuba diving. You’ll hone your skills by completing five adventure dives that introduce you to underwater navigation, deeper water diving (typically anywhere from 18-30 meters/ 60-100 feet) and a sampler of three more Adventure Dives of your choice

The course includes:

- Two compulsory dives – Deep dive and Under water navigation
- Three recommended your instructor will help you to chose the best.
- Dive manuals, tables, log books and coaching
- On completion, a certificate is issued by PADI be used till PADI

Age Limit: 10 years and above



## RESCUE DIVER COURSE

Scuba divers describe the PADI Rescue Diver course as the most challenging, yet most rewarding course they've ever taken. Why? Because you learn to prevent and manage problems in the water, and become more confident in your skills as a diver, knowing that you can help others if needed. During the course, you learn to become a better buddy by practicing problem solving skills until they become second nature. Plus, the course is just fun – it's serious, but still allows for lots of laughter in between the focused learning.

PADI (Junior) Adventure Divers who are at least 12 years old and have completed the Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive may enroll in a Rescue Diver course. You also need to have Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care (CPR and First Aid) training within the past 24 months. You can complete this training during the Rescue Diver course. Your instructor may also offer the PADI Emergency Oxygen Provider specialty diver course at the same time.

The PADI Rescue Diver course prepares you to deal with dive emergencies, minor and major, using a variety of techniques. Through knowledge development and rescue exercises, you learn what to look for and how to respond. During rescue scenarios, you put into practice your knowledge and skills. Topics include:

- Self rescue
- Recognizing and managing stress in other divers
- Emergency management and equipment
- Rescuing panicked divers
- Rescuing unresponsive divers



Register for [Rescue Diver Online](#) – PADI's eLearning option – to start now. You progress through five knowledge development sections using a web-based system that lets you learn at your own pace through an easy-to-use, interactive program. You also have access to an online version of the *Rescue Diver Manual* for reference during and after the course.

If you prefer, you can choose to study with the *Rescue Diver Manual* and watch the *Rescue Diver Video* (a book and DVD package). Go to your local PADI Dive Center and Resort to enroll in the course, get your materials and start learning. Your PADI Instructor will meet with you to schedule knowledge review sessions along with your rescue exercises and scenarios.



# DIVEMASTER COURSE

The PADI Divemaster course is your first level of professional training. Working closely with a PADI Instructor, you'll fine-tune your dive skills, like perfecting the effortless hover, and refine your rescue skills so you anticipate and easily solve common problems. You'll gain dive knowledge, management and supervision abilities so you become a role model to divers everywhere.

As a PADI Divemaster, you'll lead others as you supervise scuba diving activities and assist with diver training. Whether you want to work at a faraway dive destination or close to home at a local dive shop, the adventure of a lifetime awaits you. PADI Divemasters are respected dive professionals who are aligned with the largest and most respected dive organization in the world – PADI.

- PADI Rescue Divers who are at least 18 years old may enroll in the PADI Divemaster course. You also need to have:
- Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care (CPR and First Aid) training within the past 24 months.
- A medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- At least 40 logged dives to begin the course and 60 dives to earn certification.

The PADI Divemaster course teaches you to be a leader and take charge of dive activities. Through knowledge development sessions, waterskills exercises and workshops, and hands-on practical assessment, you develop the skills to organize and direct a variety of scuba diving activities. Topics and practical workshops include:

- The role and characteristics of the PADI Divemaster
- Supervising dive activities and assisting with student divers
- Diver safety and risk management
- Divemaster conducted programs and specialized skills
- Business of diving and your career
- Awareness of the dive environment
- Dive setup and management
- Mapping an open water site
- Conducting dive briefings
- Organizing a search and recovery project and a deep dive
- Conducting a scuba review and skin diver course
- Assisting with Discover Scuba Diving and leading Discover Local Diving programs

Your instructor may also offer the PADI Deep Diver and Search and Recovery Diver specialty diver courses along with your divemaster training to help you meet all requirements and to broaden your abilities.







## ***PADI Specialties Courses***

### ***BOAT DIVER***

The PADI Boat Diver course will expand your knowledge about boats from small inflatables to large liveaboards. You'll gain experience scuba diving by completing two dives from a boat in your local area and learn:

Boat terminology.

Boat diving procedures and etiquette, including how to enter and exit, and where to stow your gear.

Boating safety, including how to locate safety equipment.

Get credit! The first dive of this PADI Specialty Diver course may credit as an Adventure Dive toward your Advanced Open Water Diver certification – ask your instructor about earning credit.



## ***DEEP DIVER***

The lure of the deep. There's something exciting and mysterious about exploring deeper dive sites while scuba diving. Sometimes it's a wreck that attracts you below 18 metres/60 feet, and on wall dives it may be a giant fan or sponge. Whatever it is, to scuba dive with confidence at depths down to 40 metres/130 feet, you should take the PADI Deep Diver Specialty course.

If you've earned the PADI Adventure Diver rating or higher, and you're at least 15 years old, you can enroll in the Deep Diver course.

Your training starts by reviewing reasons for deep diving and how important it is to know your personal limits. During four deep dives with your instructor, you'll go over:

Specialized deep diving equipment.

Deep dive planning, buddy contact procedures and buoyancy control.

Managing your gas supply, dealing with gas narcosis and safety considerations.

You may be able to get college credit for the Deep Diver course – ask your instructor.





## ENRICHED AIR DIVER

The PADI Enriched Air Diver course is PADI's most popular specialty scuba course. Why? Because scuba diving with enriched air nitrox gives you more no decompression time, especially on repetitive scuba dives. If staying down longer and getting back in the water sooner sounds appealing, then don't hesitate to become an enriched air diver.

If you're a PADI (Junior) Open Water Diver who is at least 12 years old, you can enroll in the Enriched Air Diver Specialty course. Note that in some regions the minimum age is older than 12.



You'll learn why diving with air that has higher oxygen and lower nitrogen content gives you more bottom time, along with enriched air equipment considerations. During a practical session, and two optional (or required) scuba dives, you'll:

- Discuss managing oxygen exposure.
- Practice analyzing oxygen content in your scuba tank.
- Set your dive computer for diving with enriched air nitrox.
